

# Permanent Post in the Mail Regarding ELP Testing and Training

## 1. Eligibility Criteria for ELP Training (ab-initio) (Initial training for Pilots who have passed English language exam in class 10 or 10+2 examination.)

A candidate appearing for the Aviation English Language Proficiency Training shall comply with the following requirements:

- i. **Age:** She/he shall not be less than Sixteen years of age on the date of application.
- ii. **Educational Qualifications:** She/he shall have passed the English Language Exam in class 10 or 10+2 Examination
- iii. He/she shall have **passed all the required written examinations** for issue of licence (CPL)
- iv. Duration of training is 30 hrs

An ab-initio candidate appearing for ELP training should carry the following documents:

1. Licence in Original
2. Fee Receipt ( for External candidates)
3. Fee for 30 hrs of training is Rs.56,640 ( for external candidates)

## 2. Eligibility Criteria for ELP Testing (ab-initio) (Initial testing for Pilots who have passed English language exam in class 10 or 10+2 examination.)

A candidate appearing for the Aviation English Language Proficiency test for the first time shall comply with the following requirements:

- i. **Age:** She/he shall not be less than sixteen years of age on the date of application.
- ii. **Educational Qualifications:** She/he shall have passed English Language Exam in class 10 or 10+2 Examination
- iii. He/she shall have at least **30 hours of Aviation English Training** from a DGCA approved organisation
- iv. He/she shall have **passed all the required written examinations** for issue of licence (CPL)
- v. Duration of test is 45 minutes
- vi. Results shall be declared within two working days

Ab-initio candidate appearing for ELP test should be allowed to appear for the test after scrutinizing the following documents:

1. Licence in Original
2. EGCA-ID
3. Company ID (if applicable)
4. Fee Receipt ( for external candidates)
5. ELP Training Certificate
6. Fee for testing is Rs. 9440 ( for external candidates)

### **3. Eligibility Criteria for ELP Re-Evaluation**

**[Existing ELP level 4(once in 03 years) and Existing ELP level 5 (once in 06years)]**

A candidate appearing for ELP re-evaluation should carry the following documents:

1. Licence in Original
2. ELP endorsement page
3. EGCA-ID
4. Company ID (if applicable)
5. Fee Receipt ( for external candidates)
6. Fee for test is Rs. 9440 ( for external candidates)
7. Duration of test is 30 minutes
8. Results shall be declared within two working days

### **4. Eligibility Criteria for ELP Re-Test ( Candidates who fall below Operational level-4)**

A candidate appearing for the Aviation English Language Proficiency Re- test shall comply with the following requirements:

- i. He/she shall have at least 30 hours of Aviation English Language Training or as recommended by English Language Specialist Expert (Rater-2) of the testing team whichever is higher from a DGCA approved organisation

A candidate appearing for ELP re-test should carry the following documents:

1. Licence in Original
2. EGCA-ID
3. Company ID (if applicable)
4. Fee Receipt ( for external candidates)
5. ELP Training Certificate
6. Latest ELP rating certificate
7. Fee for test is Rs. 9440 ( for external candidates)
8. Duration of test is 45 minutes
9. Results shall be declared within two working days

### **5. ELP Re- Rating Procedure**

1. Applicants who feel their scores are not accurate may request for re-rating of their test.
2. In such cases, the test taker may appeal to DGCA in writing against the rating assessed by the testing team within 30 days from the date of test result declaration.
3. The appeal shall clearly justify the extenuating circumstances that affected the test takers performance.
4. Test takers who claim that they were having a bad day or nervous shall not be allowed to appeal since they will need to communicate in operational situations when they are having a bad day or feeling nervous.
